1. Bovine extract: Can carry many types of bovine blood-borne viruses, and is one of the primary sources of vaccine contaminants.

- 2. Gelatin: Many reported cases of allergy and anaphylaxis. (Additional vaccines with gelatin: Varivax (chickenpox), Zostavax (shingles), Fluzone (influenza), TriHibIt (DTaP + HiB), polio and MMR.)
- 3. 2-phenoxyethanol: Also called ethylene glycol. Know to be toxic to kidneys, nervous system and liver. A replacement for thimerosal.
- **4. Formaldehyde:** The EPA and IARC have classified formaldehyde as a human carcinogen at any dose. <u>http://www.cancer.gov/cancertopics/factsheet/Risk/formaldehyde</u>
- 5. Polysorbate 80: Numerous studies have shown this stabilizer can cause infertility:
- 6. ***Themerosal:** Used during manufacturing in these vaccines said to have <0.3mcg/dose. According to the FDA, the exact quantities in the vials have not been confirmed by independent testing. (+) Multidose vials with thimerosal 25mcg/dose.
